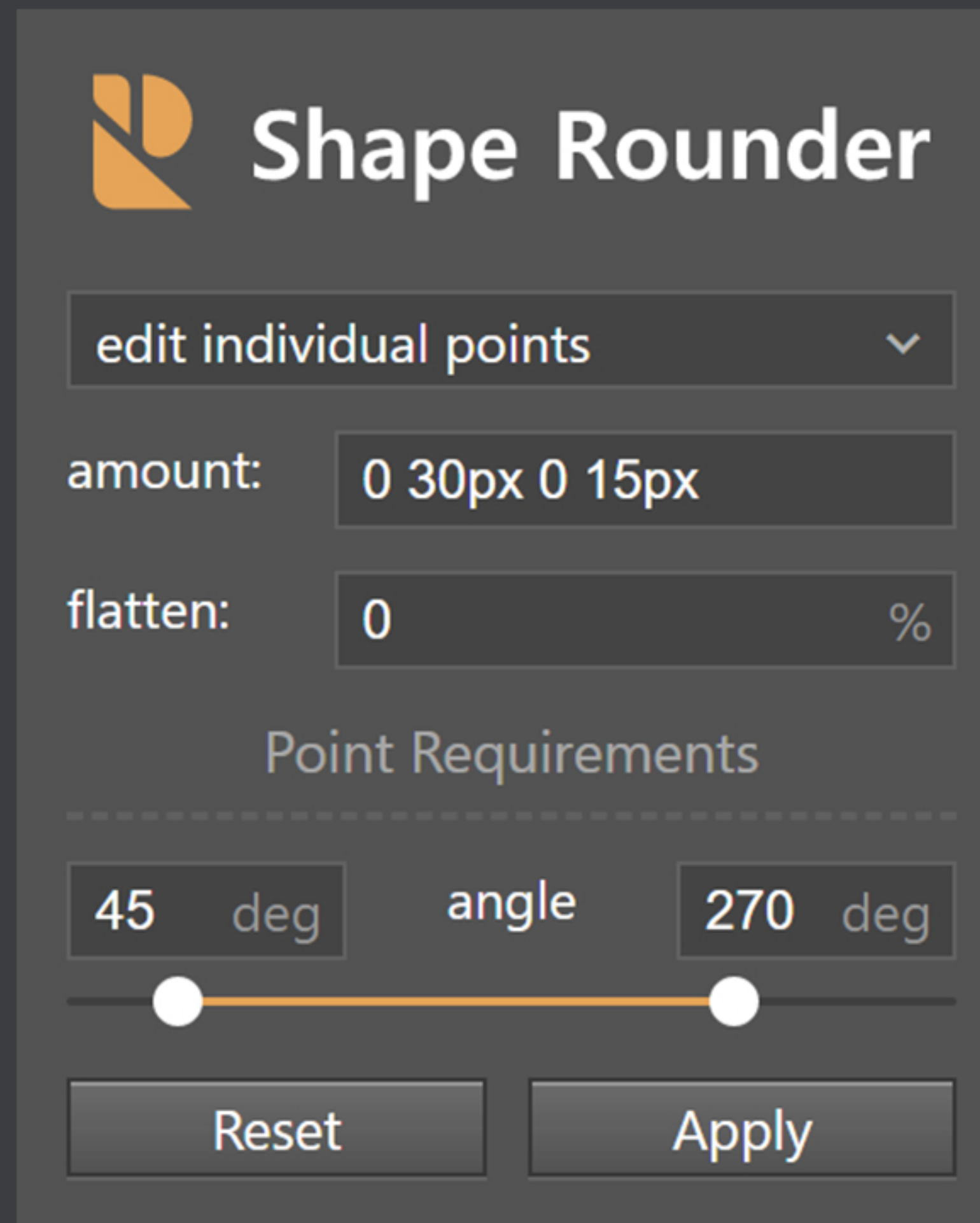


Function Overview



Rounding Amount (Pattern)

Define how much rounding will be applied. This is a repeated pattern, so you can enter one value or multiple (separated by spaces).

Filter Points by Direction Change

Usually you just want corner points to get rounded. At already curving points, the path barely changes direction, so you can filter them out by setting a minimum of 10° for example.

Keep App in Background (Start Faster)

Save Original Path Data in Layer

Original Path gets written to the Shapelayers metadata, so you can reset all changes even after closing the document or the panel.

Show input fields for each point:

Opens a dropdown where you can edit each point individually. The values automatically get synced with the amount & flatten pattern field.

Flatten Amount (Pattern)

Adjust the rounded parts to be more sharp / flat.
0%: Default, natural curve transition
-100%: Sharp curve
100%: Completely flat / cut off

Reset / Apply Changes

Apply the rounding or reset your shape / path to the original, cached state. You can also press enter inside each input to apply the rounding.

Show Point Counts (On Open Dropdown)

Not sure at which point your shape starts? Keep this on to show index numbers.

Clear Current or Global Path Cache

You made changes to your path but the panel still remembers the outdated one? Simply reset the remembered paths here.
